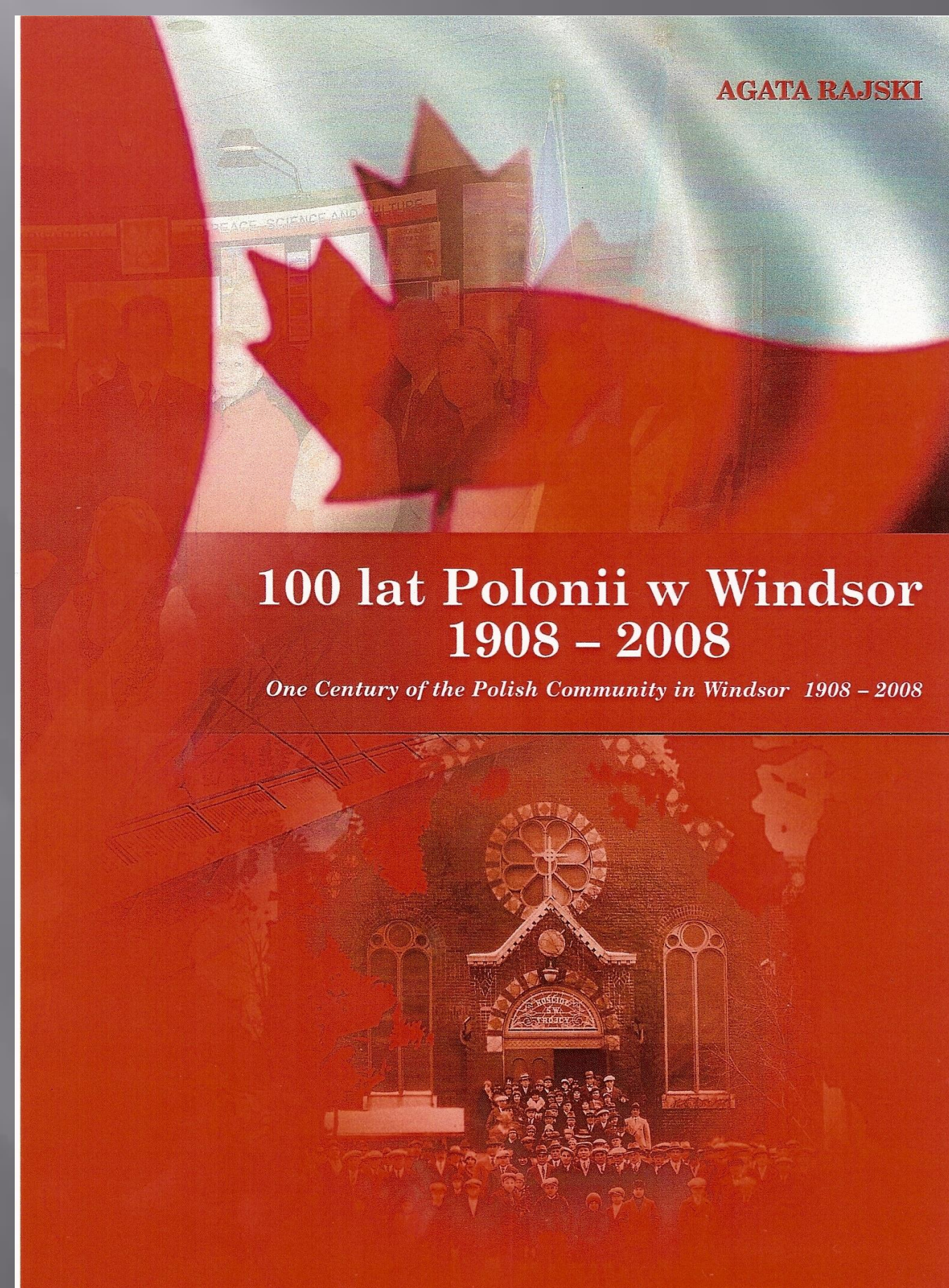
Visit of Science Delegation to Windsor, 2008
