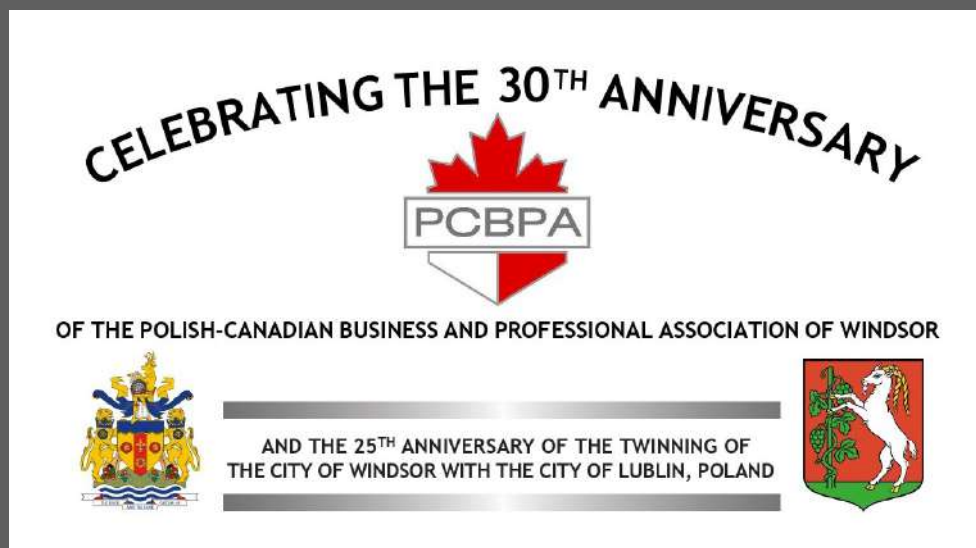

Polonia Bids Farewell to Józef Palimąka

With great sorrow, we inform the Polish community in the Windsor-Chatham region and across Canada that on March 1, 2025, at the age of 98, Mr. Józef Palimąka passed away. He was born on May 9, 1926, in Czaple Male, Poland. A Siberian exile and a soldier of the Polish Armed Forces, he journeyed through the Middle East before reaching Great Britain, where he served as a mechanic in the renowned 303 Airforce Polish Fighter Squadron.

After World War II, he emigrated to Canada. Since 1955, he had been a member of the Polish-Canadian Club in Chatham and after 1985 the Polish Airmen's Association in Detroit, USA.

From 2002, he served on the Board of the Canadian Polish Congress, Windsor-Chatham Branch, and since 2012, as a member of the Polish-Canadian Business and Professional Association in Windsor.

Mr. Palimąka was an enterprising businessman and the owner of Four Stars, a machinery manufacturing company in Chatham, which he led until his retirement in 1985. Throughout his life, he was deeply involved in many initiatives supporting the Polish-Canadian community. A true patriot and an exceptionally noble individual, he was honored with numerous military and state decorations, including the Knight's Cross of the Order of Polonia Restituta in 2019.

We have lost a remarkable man with a generous heart, leaving behind a legacy of achievements. Mr. Józef Palimąka will forever remain in our memory, serving as an inspiring example for many.

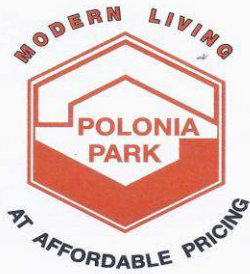

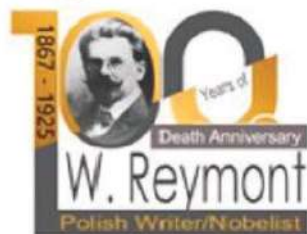

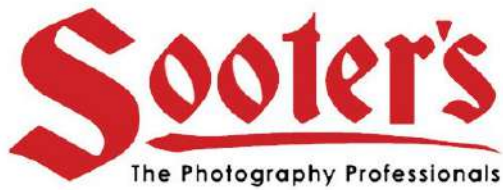

Visit by Windsor Delegation to Lublin, Poland, 2025

The recent visit of the City of Windsor delegation to Lublin, Poland, marked a significant milestone in the longstanding partnership between our two cities. Held on July 25–26, 2025, the visit was a special occasion for joint commemoration of the 25th anniversary of the Windsor-Lublin twinning agreement, established in 2000, while also exploring new avenues for cooperation in the light of the current global geopolitical landscape.

The Windsor delegation was Councillor Angelo Marignani, Chair of the City of Windsor's International Relations Committee, and Jerry Barycki, Committee Member and Honorary Consul of the Republic of Poland in Windsor, Ontario.

During this working visit to Lublin—Windsor's sister city—the delegation reaffirmed the strength and continuity of our bilateral relationship. The visit highlighted Lublin's remarkable progress and modernization efforts and provided a platform for meaningful discussions on enhancing collaboration in the areas of culture, education, and economic development.

Our meetings focused on identifying and supporting joint initiatives that will benefit both communities, deepening the spirit of partnership and mutual understanding that has characterized the Windsor-Lublin relationship for a quarter of a century.



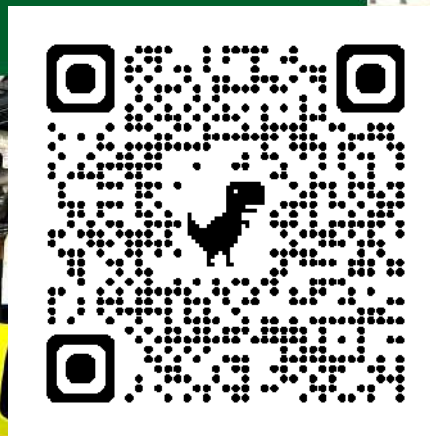

Poland and Canada Strategic Partners

On August 25, 2025, Canadian Prime Minister Mark Carney made his first official visit to Poland. He met with political leaders, military representatives, and members of the business communities from both countries, focusing on cooperation in the areas of trade, defense, and energy security, with particular emphasis on nuclear energy.

Prime Minister Carney also met with President Karol Nawrocki. During their conversation, both leaders highlighted the importance of Canadian-Polish military cooperation within NATO. They also discussed the current international situation, including matters related to the security of Ukraine, Europe, and ongoing peace talks.



During his meeting with Prime Minister Donald Tusk, both heads of government reaffirmed the close, enduring, and “exemplary” friendship between Poland and Canada, based not only on shared interests, but also on common values. They announced a deepening of the strategic partnership.

June 17, 2025 – Major Aviation Deal: LOT Polish Airlines Orders 40 Airbus A220 Aircraft from Canada

In a landmark move to modernize its fleet and strengthen transatlantic ties, LOT Polish Airlines, Poland's national carrier, has announced the purchase of 40 state-of-the-art Airbus A220 aircraft, with options for an additional 44. The agreement marks one of the largest investments in the airline's history and further deepens the aviation partnership between Poland and Canada. Manufactured in Mirabel, Québec, the Airbus A220 is known for its exceptional fuel efficiency, reduced emissions, and enhanced passenger comfort. This strategic acquisition will support LOT's ongoing efforts to expand its global network while lowering its environmental footprint. This milestone deal not only underscores the strong economic relationship between Poland and Canada, but also highlights Canada's growing role in the global aerospace industry.
